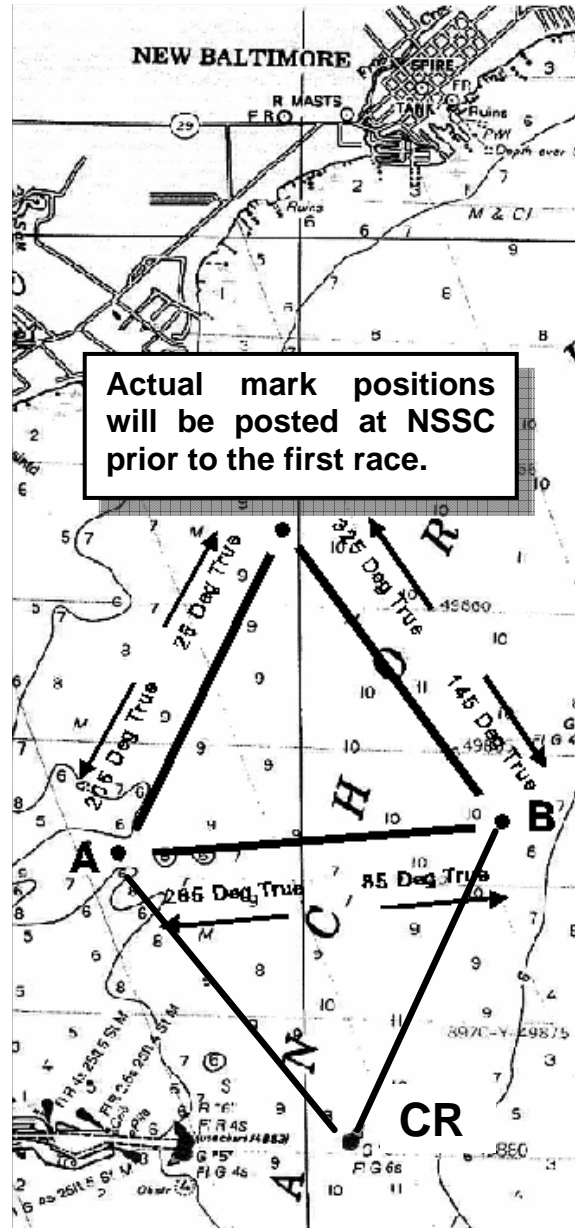

North Star Sail Club is the organizing authority and will provide race management.

Rules: USSA The Racing Rules of Sailing (2005-2008), 2007 Anchor Bay Yacht Racing Association (ABYRA) Handbook, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions shall govern the race.

Eligibility: Races are open to sail yachts owned or chartered by individual members of clubs or associations which are members in good standing of ABYRA, DRYA and/or USSA, and who have paid their race fees. In the event of a boat without a rating, the RC will assign a temporary rating.

Classes: JAM, and Spinnaker classes. Class splits will be posted at NSSC clubhouse no later than 2 hours before the race. Five boats required for a one-design start.

Start Time: The Warning signal for the first class will be listed on the Sailing Instructions.

Registration: Registration shall be submitted on the official entry form with entry fee and rating certificate.

Completed entry forms shall be received by 12 Noon on the day prior to an event and can be mailed to NSSC or deposited in the NSSC drop slot. Late entries will be accepted and will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be available at NSSC and NSSC web site (www.northstarsail.org) no later than one week prior to an event. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted at NSSC on the day of the race. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the Official Notice Board for notices.

Course: Courses will be on the Anchor Bay Triangle or as noted on the Sailing Instructions. Course selection will be visually communicated to competitors prior to the warning signal. Course configurations and visual signals are documented in the Sailing Instructions and/or in the ABYRA Handbook.

Awards: Overall and class awards will be presented following each race.

The skipper must assure that all required United States Coast Guard equipment, as well as other necessary safety equipment, is aboard, properly maintained and stowed, and that the crew knows where it is kept and how it is used.
