LEUKEMIA CUP REGATTA
NOTICE OF RACE/SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 This regatta will be governed by the rules defined in *the racing rules of sailing 2009-2012*.
- 2 The regatta is open to all boats registered with the North Star Sail club Leukemia cup committee
- 3 The regatta will be held on July 9,2011. There will be one race with the first warning at 1300 hours.
- 4 Ratings used will be standard NSSC ratings. For those boats Without a rating NSSC race committee will issue a rating.
- 5 There will be two classes, a cruising class and a racing class. The cruising class will be the first start. The cruising class will use a start with a boats start time determined by it's rating. The warning will be made at 1300 hours followed one minute later by the start of the slowest boats (those with the largest PHRF number rating). The remainder of the fleet will start at intervals determined by their rating difference. The race committee will moniter the start and announce starting times on VHF channel 72. This changes rule 26.

One minute after the last cruising class starts, the race committee will give the attention signal for racing class using the standard rule 26 start sequence
- 6 Courses: The starting area and finish line will be in the vicinity of CR. The start line and finish line will be between the RC boat and an Orange mark set 90 degrees to the wind. Both classes will have a downwind start.

The cruising class will proceed to a fixed mark identified by a shape on the RC boat (A, B, C or CR) and then to second fixed mark shown on the RC boat and then to the finish.

The racing class will sail a four-legged windward leeward course using the first mark of the cruising class as the downwind mark and the pin end of the start line as the weather mark.

- 7 There will be a one-hour time limit on each class.
