It shall be the sole and inescapable responsibility of the skipper and crew of the yacht to decide whether to start or not to start, to continue or to finish a high level of enjoyment. The skipper must assure that all required United States Coast Guard equipment, other necessary safety equipment, and humorous props, are aboard, properly maintained and stowed, and that the crew knows where it is kept and how it is used.
