Re: COVID 19 Pre-Race Screening Program

It is important to realize that any interpersonal activity involves some risk for transmission of COVID 19 and this includes sailing. Therefore, it is up to individual race teams to determine what measures to employ on your individual vessel before, during and after racing.

In an effort to limit risk to our membership and guests participating in racing of infection, we have developed a pre-race, online questionnaire which allows your crew to screen before racing for COVID symptoms or exposures. This is a free and optional service provided to our valued racing community.

The program will work as follows:

- Crew are directed to the online link found here and on our racing webpage to complete a simple questionnaire which should take less than 2 minutes.

- At noon on the day of the Twilight Race Series, the data will be compiled. Individuals with questionable symptoms will be called and, if necessary, advised to not race that night.
- A complete list of crew who have been prescreened will be forwarded to Skippers by early afternoon via email
